4. Submit the completed worksheet, tax forms, W2's, and any other documents Montreat College requests to the Financial Aid Office.
5. The Financial Aid Office will compare information on this worksheet and any supporting documents with the information you submitted on your application. You or Montreat College may need to make corrections.
