



Church Matching Grant Application for 2009-2010

Montreat College and your local church can work as partners in preparing today's students to be tomorrow's Christian leaders. Montreat invites churches to help their youth secure the resources that they need in order to finance their education at a Christian college.

Through the matching grant program, any church that gives funds to an eligible student will make it possible for that student to receive a matching grant up to a \$1,000 maximum. The church is not limited to a maximum gift of \$1,000, but additional funds above \$1,000 will not be matched.

To be eligible, an entering freshman must have a 1000 SAT and unweighted 2.75 GPA or an equivalent according to Montreat's Admissions Index. A continuing or transfer student must have a 2.50 cumulative collegiate GPA. The grant is renewable each year if the student maintains a 2.50 GPA.

Student's Church Matching Checklist:

- Student must be accepted for admission and have their \$100 advanced deposit paid by April 1.
- Pledge form secured from church and mailed to Montreat by **May 1**.
- Check for pledge is sent by church and received at Montreat by **August 15**.

Montreat College will notify each student on the Financial Aid Award Letter of the amount Montreat will match.
