

FERPA RELEASE AUTHORIZATION

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) requires the Financial Aid and Registrar's Offices to release information pertaining to the student's record only to the student. Students may, however, voluntarily waive their FERPA rights to the person(s) they choose to authorize access to their academic and financial information. By completing this form, the named person(s) will have the ability to obtain information regarding the student's financial aid file and academic record.

Since Montreat College is unable to release information pertaining to a student without proper identifiers, those who are authorized access must be able to provide the student's birth date and social security number.
