An applicant for graduation may petition to participate in a commencement ceremony. To be eligible to petition, a student must:

- Have only one course, one academic requirement, or less than one music proficiency level outstanding from meeting all graduation requirements (specific departments may have individual requirements that must be met).
- Have fulfilled all other degree and exit requirements.
- Be in good financial standing.
- Plan to complete the outstanding courses or requirement by the end of the next conferral period.

Petitions should address specific plans for completing the remaining course or requirement with expected completion dates along with supporting documentation. Students who are approved to walk in commencement must reapply for the next conferral period (August, December, or May) by the posted deadline. **Students may participate in only one commencement ceremony per degree.**
