

AMENDED AND RESTATED CHARTER

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OF

RUFUS L EDMISTEN SECRETARY OF STATE NORTH CAROLINA

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MONTREAT-ANDERSON COLLEGE, INCORPORATED

The undersigned non-profit corporation, for the purpose of amending and restating its charter, in accordance with the provisions of Section 55A-36 and 37.1 of the North Carolina Non-Profit Corporation Act, does hereby set forth:

- The name of the Corporation is Montreat-Anderson College, Incorporated.
- 2. At a regularly convened meeting of the Trustees of the Corporation held on the 23rd day of October, 1992, the following Amended and Restated Charter was adopted:
 - I. The name of the Corporation is Montreat-Anderson College, Incorporated.
 - II. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
 - III. This Charter acknowledges and affirms the heritage and the affiliation of Montreat-Anderson College, Incorporated with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), including any antecedent and subsequent forms of either organization. As a church-related college, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
 - (a) To operate educational institutions, giving instruction in liberal arts and all ordinary branches of academic and collegiate education with a Christian perspective, so as to enable students to receive a sound and thorough education within the context and tradition of the Christian faith and in keeping with its

heritage and affiliations as acknowledged above.

- (b) To operate summer schools, summer camps and such other auxiliary operations and institutions as the Board of Trustees may deem necessary or proper.
- In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, to exercise such other powers which now are or hereafter conferred by law corporation organized for the purposes herein set forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation, subject to furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation and as may be exercised by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
- IV. The Corporation shall have no members.
- V. Except for the initial Trustees as named in the corporation's Articles of Incorporation, who have subsequently resigned, the affairs of the corporation shall be governed by a Board of Trustees. The number of the Trustees constituting the Board of Trustees shall not be less than twelve (12) nor more than thirty-six (36). At least a majority of such members of the Board of Trustees shall be active members of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The number of Trustees, their terms of office and the method and time of selecting such Trustees shall be as provided for in the bylaws of the corporation.
- VI. No part of the net earnings or funds of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Officer or Trustee of the Corporation or other individual (except

that the Corporation shall have the power to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 3 hereof), and no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to legislation; nor shall the Corporation intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public Notwithstanding any other provision of these office. Articles, the Corporation shall not conduct activities not permitted to be conducted by organization except under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and upon dissolution of the Corporation, the assets thereof shall, after all of its liabilities and obligations have been discharged or adequate provision made therefore, be distributed to any organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by the Clerk of Superior Court of the North Carolina County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located to such organization or organizations as such Clerk of Superior Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes and at the time qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended.

VII. The address of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of North Carolina is P.O. Box 1267, 310 Gaither Circle, Montreat, Buncombe County,

North Carolina 28757; and the name of its registered agent at such address is William Hurt. The number of Trustees constituting the Board of Trustees is not less than twelve (12) nor more than thirty-six (36) and the names and addresses of the persons who are currently serving as the Trustees are:
