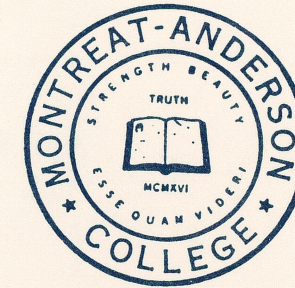
THE MACE AND THE BANNER
