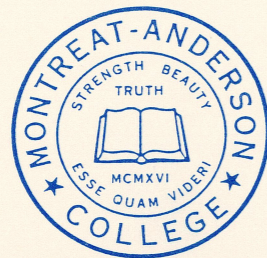

THE COLLEGE SEAL

The seal of Montreat-Anderson College is composed of concentric circles surrounding the open book of learning and the Word of God. The words "Montreat-Anderson College" encompass the ideals of strength, beauty, and truth above the Latin motto meaning "to be rather than to seem." The date of the founding of the College, 1916, completes the emblem.



THE MACE AND THE BANNER

The College mace symbolizes the authority of the President and is present in all official College convocations. The Montreat-Anderson mace is of walnut and silver, representing the simplicity and strength of the Cross of Christ, the open Bible, and the lamp of knowledge, transcendent over the seal of the College. The Celtic cross, the open Bible, and the word TRUTH represent the focus of Montreat-Anderson College.

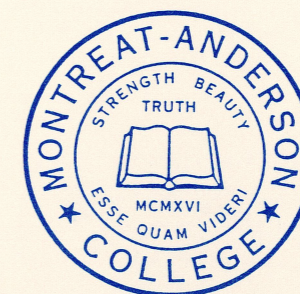
THE INAUGURATION OF WILLIAM WHITFIELD HURT

President of Montreat-Anderson College

On April 11, 1992, William W. Hurt was inaugurated as the fifth president of Montreat-Anderson College. In his inaugural address, President Hurt challenged the College to "become distinguished as a serving institution, developing servant leadership." He stated further that "A college that understands servant leadership will develop students who will be the 'givers' rather than the 'takers' of society. They will wear their servanthood into the world like an invisible crown." Mr. Hurt continues the College's tradition of noble and dedicated servant leadership.
