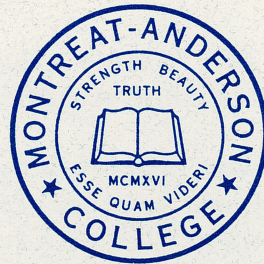

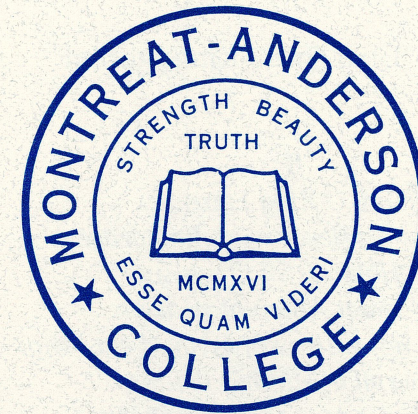


## THE MACE AND THE BANNER

He has been active in the treatment of patients with substance abuse for over 30 years and has become a renowned national authority. He is an elder in the First Presbyterian Church, Nashville, TN and a PC(USA) denominational leader in his field.*
