# HONORARY DEGREE AND AWARD RECIPIENTS

W. Frank Harrington

Frank Harrington serves as senior minister of the 11,500 member Peachtree Presbyterian Church, Atlanta, Georgia. During his twenty-seven year pastorate, more than 15,500 members have been received and the congregation has given 46 percent of income to benevolent causes at home and abroad. Dr. Harrington's remarkable service to the church, community and higher education includes chairmanship of the Board of Trustees of Presbyterian College and leadership on numerous other civic boards and Christian agencies. The new Center for Continuing Education and Church Growth at Columbia Theological Seminary in Atlanta bears his name. He is the author of two books. His nine honorary degrees from institutions in the U. S. and abroad attest to a lifetime of achievement and service. Dr. Harrington will be presented the honorary Doctor of Letters.

William Lee Warlick and Nancy Wooddell Warlick

The Reverend William Warlick and Nancy Warlick have served as coordinators of the Project of Evangelism and Church Growth in Africa for the Presbyterian Church since 1984. This project, originally targeted for Ghana and Zaire, has been so successful that it now reaches into seventeen African countries. Designed to help indigenous churches minister to groups of people previously not exposed to Christianity, it fosters leadership development and new church growth through the construction of schools and churches, and reaches villages where there is no Christian church. The Warlicks received the Bell-MacKay Award for outstanding service to the church in 1996. Mr. and Mrs. Warlick will each be presented the honorary Doctor of Humane Letters.

Charles Alexander Hunter, Sr.

Charles Hunter, former chairman of the Montreat College Board of Trustees, served on the board for eighteen years until his death in January 1996. He was a founding director of the Montreat College Foundation. Mr. Hunter was president and general manager of Hunter Jersey Farms and chairman and co-founder of Republic Bank and Trust Company (now CCB) in Charlotte. A Presbyterian elder since 1942, he had been a delegate to the General Assembly and moderator of the Mecklenburg Presbytery. He was active in Rotary International, Boy Scouts of America, Boys Home, and on the Salvation Army Board. Mr. Hunter will be presented posthumously the Distinguished Service Award. Accepting on his behalf will be his beloved wife of many years, Trustee Lucielle Gwaltney Hunter.

The College mace symbolizes the authority of the President and is present in all official College convocations. The Montreat mace is of walnut and silver, representing the simplicity and strength of the Cross of Christ, the open Bible, and the lamp of knowledge, transcendent over the seal of the College. The College banner features an arched window opening onto the mountains, framing heaven and earth. The Montreat College logo inside the arch rises over symbols of the College's purpose: the Bible represents the foundation of the College's Christ-centered education; the globe atop it represents the worldwide scope provided by education and the development of a Christian world view based upon the Bible's teaching. The books represent the beauty and strength of scholarship and the variety of disciplines offered by the College. The candle embodies the illumination that education and faith bring to the individual and the world.
