HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

Leighton Ford

Leighton Ford is president of Leighton Ford Ministries. He served for 31 years as vice president of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association and was also a regular alternate speaker with Billy Graham on the *Hour of Decision*. Dr. Ford serves as the honorary lifetime chairman of the Lausanne Committee for World Evangelization, having served from 1976 to 1992 as Chairman of this international body of Christian leaders. Dr. Ford serves on the boards of World Vision U.S., Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, Duke University Cancer Center, and Chrysalis Ministries. He was named "Clergyman of the Year" in 1985 by the Religious Heritage of America, and as "Presbyterian Preacher of the Year" by the National Presbyterian Center. Dr. Ford was singled out by *Time Magazine* as "among the most influential preachers of an active Gospel." He received the "Two Hungers Award" in 1990 in recognition of his contributions in addressing the physical and spiritual hungers of people around the world. As an author, he has written 10 books, including the award-winning *Sandy: A Heart for God* (the biography of his son who died during heart surgery in 1981) and his most recent book, *The Power of Story*. Dr. Ford has written *Transforming Leadership* published by InterVarsity Press, which is one of the most comprehensive books on leadership ever written. The unique Arrow Leadership Program established under his leadership has now become a continuing international program in its own right. Dr. Ford will be presented the honorary doctor of humane letters.

Samuel Hugh Moffett

Samuel Hugh Moffett graduated *summa cum laude* from Wheaton College in Illinois, earned his bachelor of theology from Princeton Theological Seminary, and earned his Ph.D. in Religion and Church History from Yale University. His further studies include the College of Chinese Studies in Peking and Cambridge University, where he was a Visiting Scholar and member of Fitzwilliam College. Dr. Moffett has been involved in missionary work to China from 1947-51 as a faculty member and to Korea from 1955-81 in the capacity of principal, chairman of the board, director, chairman, and councillor, and has been a member of several missionary boards and societies. He is currently honorary president of the Presbyterian Theological Seminary of Korea and honorary president of the Asian Center for Theological Studies and Mission (ACTS) in Seoul, Korea. Awarded the Bell-Mackay Prize in 1987 for Leadership in Missions, Dr. Moffett is currently the Henry Winters Luce Professor of Ecumenics and Mission, emeritus, at Princeton Theological Seminary. Dr. Moffett is the author of a number of books, including *History of Christianity in Asia: Vol. I, Beginnings to 1500* (1992), *First Encounters: Korea 1880-1910* (1982), and *Asia and Mission* (1976, in Korean). Dr. Moffett will be presented the honorary doctor of humane letters.
