

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

William C. Wood

Dr. William C. Wood graduated from Harvard Medical School in 1966 and became a clinical and research fellow in immunology at the surgery branch of the National Institute of Health from 1968-1970. He completed a clinical fellowship in surgery at Harvard in 1973 and completed his residency in general surgery at Massachusetts General Hospital in 1974. Before being appointed the Joseph Whitehead Professor and Chairman of the Department of Surgery at Emory University School of Medicine in 1991, Dr. Wood served as both medical director of the cancer center and chief of surgical oncology at Massachusetts General Hospital.

Among his many accomplishments, Dr. Wood is recognized both nationally and internationally for his outstanding contributions to cancer therapy and for his influence on the design and meta-analysis of conceptually driven national clinical trials. He has also been recognized in many national publications including most recently, "America's Top Doctors for Women," *Ladies Home Journal*, 2002; "America's Top Breast Cancer Doctors," *Redbook*, 2001; and "Atlanta's Top Doctors," *Atlanta Magazine*, 2001.

Dr. Wood currently serves on the Board of Governors of the American College of Surgeons; is the first vice president of the Southeastern Surgical Congress; co-chairs the Early Breast Cancer Trialists' Collaborative Group, Oxford; sits on the *Board of Scientific Advisors* of the National Cancer Institute of the NIH; and is editor-in-chief of *Oncology*, the most widely read publication in that field, and associate editor of the *American Journal of Clinical Oncology*. He has published approximately 250 journal articles and 38 book chapters, has done approximately 80 national/international visiting professorships, was co-editor of *Surgery of the Breast: Principles and Art*, principal editor of *The Anatomic Basis of Tumor Surgery* and the North American editor of the second edition of the *Oxford Textbook of Surgery*.

The seal of Montreat College is composed of concentric circles surrounding the open book of learning and the Word of God. The words “Montreat College” encompass the ideals of strength, beauty, and truth above the Latin motto meaning “to be rather than to seem.” The date of the founding of the College, 1916, completes the emblem.

THE MACE AND THE BANNER

The College mace symbolizes the authority of the President and is present in all official College convocations. The Montreat mace is of walnut and silver, representing the simplicity and strength of the Cross of Christ, the open Bible, and the lamp of knowledge, transcendent over the seal of the College. The College banner features an arched window opening onto the mountains, framing heaven and the College’s Christ-centered education; the glove atop it represents the worldwide scope provided by education and the development of a Christian worldview based upon the Bible’s teaching. The books represent the beauty and strength of scholarship and the variety of disciplines offered by the College. The candle embodies the illumination that education and faith bring to the individual and the world.
