

THE COLLEGE SEAL

The seal of Montreat College is composed of concentric circles surrounding the open book of learning and the Word of God. The words “Montreat College” encompass the ideals of strength, beauty, and truth above the Latin motto meaning “to be rather than to seem.” The date of the founding of the College, 1916, completes the emblem.

THE MACE AND THE BANNER

The College mace symbolizes the authority of the President and is present in all official College convocations. The Montreat mace is of walnut and silver, representing the simplicity and strength of the Cross of Christ, the open Bible, and the lamp of knowledge, transcendent over the seal of the College. The College banner features an arched window opening onto the mountains, framing heaven and the College’s Christ-centered education; the globe atop it represents the worldwide scope provided by education and the development of a Christian worldview based upon the Bible’s teaching. The books represent the beauty and strength of scholarship and the variety of disciplines offered by the College. The candle embodies the illumination that education and faith bring to the individual and the world.

THE COLLEGE

Since 1916, Montreat College has established a strong tradition of Christian higher education. With four campuses and a student body of approximately 1,100, the Montreat College of today is continuing in its commitment to the individual student and to the integration of learning with faith.

Montreat provides a strong academic program that is intertwined with preparation for the future through an extraordinary range of leadership, internship, and service opportunities. As the only member in North Carolina of the Washington, D.C.-based Council for Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCCU), Montreat takes seriously its role as a true Christ-centered institution of higher learning.

Montreat College is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education, and the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

Alec D. Hill

Alec D. Hill became President and Chief Executive Officer of InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA in July of 2001. InterVarsity is a nondenominational ministry serving more than 35,000 students and faculty on nearly 550 college and university campuses nationwide. Incorporated in 1941, InterVarsity has a tradition of campus witness and Christian discipleship. It also operates an award-winning publishing arm, InterVarsity Press, and runs a triennial *Urbana Student Missions Conference*, which draws over 20,000 students.

Mr. Hill holds a B.A. in History (*summa cum laude*) and an M.A. in Biblical Studies from Seattle Pacific University. In addition, he earned a J.D. from the University of Washington School of Law. From 1995 to 2001, Mr. Hill served as Dean of the School of Business and Economics at Seattle Pacific University. For the prior decade, he was a Professor of Law and Ethics at the university. In the early 1980s, he served as Regional Director with World Relief Organization.

As dean, Mr. Hill led Seattle Pacific University’s School of Business and Economics to accreditation by AACSB (a prestigious international organization), established sister school relations with the Warsaw School of Economics and obtained major grants. As a professor, he has published numerous articles, consulted with World Vision on homelessness and Amerasian children, developed M.B.A. curricula in Russia, authored an InterVarsity Press book entitled *Just Business: Christian Ethics in the Marketplace* (also published in the U.K. and Hong Kong) and presented business ethics seminars in Hanoi, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Manila, and Hong Kong.

Alec Hill and his wife Mary have two teenage daughters, Laura and Carolyn. The family lives in Madison, Wisconsin.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

John William Pamplin

John William Pamplin was born to John Robert Pamplin and Pauline Boisseau Beville Pamplin on September 3, 1908, at Sutherland, Dinwiddie County, Virginia, the eldest of three sons. He graduated from Virginia Tech in 1928 with a B.S. degree in Mining Engineering and from the University of Alabama in 1929 with an M.S. degree in Mining Engineering.

Known as Bill, Mr. Pamplin was married to Helen Virginia Hughes on June 10, 1932. His dear Helen passed away on November 8, 2002. A son, John Robert, is married to the former Lynn Gilman. They live in Greenbrae, California. A daughter, Jan Hughes, is married to Michael Smith. They live in Anna Maria, Florida. Jan and Mike have two children: John Robert, who lives in Greenville, South Carolina, and David Michael, who lives in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Pamplin was employed as an engineer in 1929 by Southern Phosphate Corporation in Bartow, Florida, and except for military service during World War II, he remained with that company, which became Davison Chemical Company, until he retired in 1953 as chief engineer. He was retired from the United States Army in 1968 with the rank of colonel, after serving 38 years in the active and inactive reserve. Mr. Pamplin began growing oranges in 1936, and he continues as a part-time grower. He retired as a director of the Lake Wales Citrus Growers Association in March 1999 after 43 years of service.

He is a long time member of the First Presbyterian Church, Rotary Club, and Chamber of Commerce in Bartow, Florida. He and his wife Helen moved from their home in Bartow to a retirement community, Freedom Village in Bradenton, Florida, in January 2000. Together, Helen and Bill Pamplin traveled to more than 60 countries during their 70 years together. Mr. Pamplin will be presented the honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree.
