THIS BUILDING would be a replica of the Crosby Adams' studio with the same southern exposure. The windows would be about the same distance from the ground, looking out on a similar slanted hillside. The interior to be an exact copy of the music room containing the two pianos, the library of music, and the library of books, the basket and shell collections, the many scrap books, the chairs and pictures, all as they are now. The exterior would be of stone, a part of the present Crosby Adams Fine Arts Building at Montreat, North Carolina, and yet a separate absolutely fireproof structure. The cost to be about \$20,000.

WHY?

- (1) There is nowhere in our country another couple who have so consecrated their lives to music, who have inspired more people with their steadfast dedication to their own ideals, and have made everyone who knows them conscious of the true greatness of their characters. Their ninety-two years have been a benediction to all.
- (2) There is nation-wide interest in the Crosby Adams. Many have been their students from all over the United States. Teachers have come from most of the forty-eight states and several foreign countries to learn in Teacher's classes which they have conducted for more than half a century.
- (3) Their priceless possessions should have a safe place—a fireproof place. This to us, their music-loving friends, is an important fact.

How Shall This Be Financed?

- (1) This project should be sponsored by the National Federation of Music Clubs and should be one of the projects on the rating sheet, along with the other worthwhile projects to which all clubs contribute.
- (2) A concentrated effort should be made at once, while this greatly beloved couple still lives, to interest every music club, adult and junior, to have a part in its building.
- (3) Also, we should interest the fourteen or more clubs and societies of which Mrs. Crosby Adams is a member or honorary member.
