Summary: Montreat College seeks a faculty member in Exercise Science who will also instruct Natural Science and other courses as needed. This is a full-time position.

Duties and Responsibilities: The candidate will be responsible for teaching courses in exercise science, including but not limited to anatomy and physiology, rehabilitation and therapeutic modalities, exercise testing, first aid and CPR; biology; lab courses; and other courses determined by background and departmental needs. Additional responsibilities include advising students, participating in faculty committees, and other duties as described in the Faculty Handbook.
